

CAMPUS



Parking is extremely limited throughout campus, so please plan accordingly. Upon request families can receive one parking pass at check-in to be used in designated lots on the thurs-fri of Family Weekend. Most Parking restrictions are lifted daily at 4:30 p.m. and all-day Saturday - Sunday. Guests who utilize handicap accessible parking will need the family weekend parking pass as well as their state issued Disabled Persons Parking Placard. **Scan this QR code to view a campus map.**

GAMEDAY



Gameday parking is very limited, but not impossible! No parking pass is needed for Saturday, as all parking restrictions are lifted. **Use the QR code to get a digital version of the map that is located on pg 13-14.** Whether or not you decide to drive is up to you, but we recommend using the Regional Transit System (RTS) or Ride Sharing instead of parking on Saturday. Please do not park in reserved spaces or service drives.

Glear Bag Policy

Don't worry, the clear bag you got at Family Weekend check-in is useable for the game!



APPROVED BAGS

- Clear plastic, vinyl or PVC bags that do not exceed 12"x6"x12"
 - A logo no larger than 4.5"x 3.4" can be displayed on one side of a permissible clear bag.
 - A clear bag shall be clear from top-to-bottom and up to a 2" trim/border on the bag is generally acceptable.
- ✓ One-gallon clear, re-sealable plastic storage bag
- ✓ Small clutch bags no larger than 4.5"x6.5", approximately the size of a hand, with or without a handle or strap
- Medically necessary items (after proper inspection)

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Outside food or drink (including alcoholic beverages)
 - Fans are permitted to bring one commercially branded (i.e.: Aquafina) empty plastic water bottles, no larger than 20 oz., in to Ben Hill Griffin Stadium
- X Artificial Noise Makers
- × Personal seatbacks

- X Ice chests or bags
- × Strollers
- X Tobacco products (including e-cigarettes, vapor pens, and chewing tobacco)
- × Umbrellas
- X Video cameras/cases
- × Weapons
